



The British Red Ensign Flag

This flag was one of the most common flags of the British Empire during the time of the Battle of Bushy Run. After the French and Indian War, British soldiers and settlers could be found throughout Pennsylvania and much of North America.

The flag's red field and the British Union Flag in the corner showed that the land was under British rule. As you color, look for the Union Flag in the upper corner and the bright red background that made this flag easy to recognize.
